

**TITLE 4. ELECTIONS.**

4-101. Primary Election Eliminated. Election for Mayor and council members shall be conducted according to the municipal election section of the Utah Code, reference 20A-9-404(1) and (2). Candidates for Mayor and council members are to be nominated at a primary election if required. A primary election will be held only when the number of candidates filing for an office exceeds twice the number to be elected. the candidates nominated at the primary election plus candidates that were not required to run in the primary are to be placed on the November ballot. (Ord. 95-6 ~1(part))

4-102. Candidates Nominated by Declaration or Petition. Candidates for elective office in this municipality shall be determined and/or nominated by means of the procedures outlined in Section 20A-9-203 Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, wherein individuals become candidates by means of a declaration of candidacy or petition. (Ord. 95-66 ~1 (part)) (Ord. 02-03)

4-103. Application of State Law. All other provisions of the election laws of the State of Utah, not inconsistent with this chapter, are hereby accepted as the election laws and ordinances of North Logan City. This includes, but is not limited to, Section 20 and 20A of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953 as amended. (Ord. 95-6 ~1(part))
