The North Logan City Cemetery

In 2010 the City Council, City Staff, and the Cemetery Committee have accomplished the following items:

- Landscaping improved between road and grass, along with irrigation system modifications,
- Five trees were planted around the exterior of the Cemetery,
- Designed phase 2 of the Cemetery,
- Phase 2 was surveyed and the road was installed,
- Celebrations for Memorial/Veterans Day,

In 2011 we look forward to the following accomplishments:

- Finalizing the lot configuring for phase 2,
- Completing the designs for the phase 2 irrigation system, along with installation of the system,
- Planting of grass and trees for phase 2,
- Installation of lot corner survey monuments,
- Designing and master planning the remainder of the Cemetery/Parkland,
- Installation of a plaque which recognizes all of the citizens who were instrumental in the creation of the North Logan Memorial Park,
- Changing the Hyde Park Cemetery District boundary lines to match the North Logan / Hyde Park boundary taking all of North Logan properties out of the Hyde Park Cemetery District,

Here are a few details on some of the above items that we would like you to know about:

- The plot size is 4' X 10' at the cost of \$350 for a city resident. Phase 2 will be completed during FY 2012. The completion of phase 2 is needed in order to accommodate the high demand for cemetery lot purchases.
- In North Logan City there are about 500 homes, 80 lots without a home and 20 businesses on which owners are currently paying a cemetery tax to the Hyde Park Cemetery District. The City Council, City Staff, and Cemetery Committee are trying to get the property owners outside of Hyde Park City withdrawn from the Hyde Park Cemetery District. North Logan's part of this process has been completed. Completing the process requires the Hyde Park Cemetery District's approval and this should be done within the next few months and hopefully finalized with the State Attorney General before the beginning of the next tax year. If you currently pay the Hyde Park Cemetery District property tax and agree with the proposed boundary change, you may want to contact the Hyde Park Cemetery District and encourage them to finalize their part of the process.
